- 1. Chairperson's welcome.** The Chairperson, Cllr Llinos Price, welcomed everyone to the March meeting. She offered the condolences of all members to Cllr Auriol Williams and family following the loss of her mother, Mrs Mair Elias. Likewise, condolences were offered to the Reverend John Bennett, following the recent passing of Mrs Barbara Bennett. Members showed their respect in the usual manner. The Clerk agreed to forward a sympathy card to Mr Bennett.
- 2. Apologies for absence:** Cllrs Eurig Lloyd, Dilwyn Jenkins
- 3. Minutes of the previous meeting.**
It was proposed by Cllr Ann Stokoe and seconded by Cllr Peter Williams that the January minutes be recorded as correct.
- 4. Declaration of personal interests:** Nil.
- 5. Matters arising:**
 - (a) **Dog fouling:** A successful public meeting was held in the vestry of Capel Penyparc on 12 February. The possibility of using DNA technology to detect dogs and irresponsible owners was discussed. It was suggested that the "Dog Watch" scheme might be considered as adopted in St Dogmaels under the jurisdiction of Pembrokeshire County Council with members of the public monitoring the situation. The problem is on the increase in public places such as playing fields, children's play area and pathways. The staff and pupils of Ysgol Gymunedol Penyparc were thanked for their assistance in producing posters advertising the event and drawing the public's attention to this most anti-social of problems. The Chairperson, Cllr Llinos Price, and Cllr Peter Williams stated that an improvement had been noticed in the area. PCSO Matthew Kieboom mentioned that DNA testing had proved to be successful in Pembrokeshire and that an offender had been prosecuted. The Chairperson added that there was a possibility that the County Council might supply signage highlighting the £1,000 fine for offending. Cllr Clive Davies congratulated the Chairperson for organising the event and drawing the public's attention to the problem.
 - (b) **Brynteg, Ferwig:** The Clerk stated that no response had been received from Mr Bell, the owner of Brynteg. Cllr Matthew Morgan agreed to ask Mr Robert Morgan whether he might be interested to complete the work.
 - (c) **Penyparc Bus Shelters:**
 - (i) Following the correspondence between the Clerk and Mrs Meinir Davies, grants officer of the County Council, the appropriate grant form has been completed and forwarded to the department for assistance to provide a new bus shelter near the O. C. Davies & Son garage.
 - (ii) A response is awaited to the Council's request for information regarding the legal obligations of the owners of the Pwllbybwper bus shelter.
 - (d) **Evelyn Beach:** A complaint was received from Mrs Shirley Daniel regarding the condition of Evelyn's Beach in Gwbert. The Clerk was requested to inform Mrs Daniel that normally only written complaints are received by the Council. Cllr Dilwyn Jenkins is to give an update after discussing the matter with the Afon Teifi Fairways committee, the body responsible for its upkeep.
 - (e) **The community Gutters:** The work to clear the guttering is now under way.
