- (a) Baw cŵn yn Penparc – Mae hyn yn dipyn o broblem. Trafodwyd 2 problem. 1) Mae rhai pobl yn mynd a cŵn i fewn i'r cae chware plant ac ir cae pêldroed. Cynnigwyd gwneud arwyddion newydd yn atgoffa pawb ni ddylau cŵn i fod yn y lleoliadau yma. 2) Baw cŵn. Mae biniau pwrpasol i baw cŵn ar gael yn nifer o lefydd, ac maent yn cael i gwagu yn aml. Efallau y fyddau yn syniad i cael dosbarthwr bagiau baw cŵn hefyd? Fel bod yna ddim un esgus i gael i adael baw cŵn ar y palmant. Y Clerc i edrych mewn i cael dosbarthwyr.

10. Other Matters:

(a) Dog mess issues at Penparc – Two main issues were discussed – 1) Some people have been seen taking

dogs into the play area at Cae Gwyrdd and on the football pitch at Yst Berkely. It was agreed to make new signs to be put up in these locations as well as at Ferwig, reminding everyone that no dogs are allowed. 2) Dog fouling is also a problem on pavements – although several dog bins are available which are regularly emptied, there is still a considerable amount of dog mess. Some communities now offer dog bag dispensers for people to use. The clerk to investigate costs etc of these.

- (b) **Rubbish on the football pitch** – it is disappointing to see rubbish being left on the football pitch as bins cannot be located there due to Ceredigion refusing to empty them. People must take their rubbish with them.
- (c) **Broken Sty at Penparc** – the council is aware of the damage and will repair when COVID regulations allow.
- (d) **PACT meeting** – a successful meeting was held last month with several issues discussed, the next meeting is 17 June at 6.30 pm.
- (e) **Future council meetings** – new legislation has been passed outlining that meetings can be held virtually, physically or in hybrid allowing councillors to attend remotely. Each council to adopt their own preference depending on facilities available.
- (f) **LoRawan Sensor at Mwnt** – Cllr Peter Williams has been trailing a vibrating sensor at the cattle grid going to Mwnt to monitor the number of cars there daily. Currently 1436 have visited since 1/4/21 (today is 12/4/21). This data could prove invaluable in the future with regards to grants and identifying key resources needed in different areas. E.g the sensors could be linked to life saving rings when an alarm is raised if a ring is being used in an emergency. The sensors are relatively inexpensive at £100 each and can be placed in several areas – Gwbert viewpoint would be a good location but at present wifi signal is not strong enough for the sensor. Other places to be considered – Penparc and Ferwig play areas, football pitch, public footpaths etc. It was agreed to purchase 2 sensors with locations to be decided in the next council meeting.
- (g) **Gwesty Cliff benches** – It was raised by Cllr Dilwyn Jenkins that the benches the other side of the Cliff were in need to repair and repainting. Clerk to check with Mr John Morris when they were last refurbished. Some gravel also needs to be placed underneath them.
- (h) **Gwesty Cliff footpaths** – some complaints have been received regarding footpaths near to the Cliff Hotel had been closed off to members of the public. The council also placed steps down to a small beach. The clerk to make enquires regarding the footpath and whether they were accessible.

11. County Councillor's Report – Cllr Clive Davies:

- (a) Cllr Clive Davies has had a response regarding the sty in Penparc, signs at cae gwyrdd Penparc. The location of the Pengarn Pile sign has been decided just awaiting a price to come back.
- (b) Mwnt Landslide – the work to repair the recent landslide has been done ready for the easter break.
- (c) LoRawan sensors in Cardigan and Ferwig could be an important way forward to help access resources for the future.
- (d) Cardigan town Council have agreed to purchase the zoom licence for 2021/22 for use by Llechryd and Ferwig community councils. The chairman thanked cllr Clive Davies for this.
