- 5. Matters arising:**
 - (a) Hedges Cae Gwyrdd Penparc** – Teifi garden & landscapes has started on the work today.
 - (b) Hampers for the elderly** – The feedback given to members of the council had been very positive with a number contacting the council directly to express their thanks – Judith Marr, Shirley Daniel, Enid Davies; Bernard Smith; Beth Rowley; Hywelfryn & Myfanwy Jones.
 - (c) Entrance way to Penparc Chapel** - Mr George Lloyd, assistant head of highways for the A487 has been in contact with the clerk regarding the plant pots obstructing the entrance. After speaking to Mr Davies, he agreed to move one of the pots and both men felt that there were no other issues at present.
 - (d) Signage for Cae Gwyrdd in Penparc** – Again, Mr George Lloyd has been in contact regarding the location of the play area and would feed back after a visit.
 - (e) Mobile post office visits to Penparc** - The Clerk had been in contact with Jeremy Cliff to discuss a suitable site for the mobile van to visit once a week – the route would consist of Boncach, Rhyd Lewis and Parcllyn.
