11. Adroddiad y Cyngor y Cyng. Clive Davies

- (a) **Arwyddion cae chwarae:** aros am ymateb gan Geredigion ar bwy sy'n talu am yr arwyddion Newydd. Achos yn agored gyda'r Asiantaeth Cefnffyrdd - A487 Penparc Aberteifi arwyddion cae chwarae a llain welededd xref: OC-01291-20 (Rhys Ryland).
- (b) **Mwnt:** Wedi cysylltu â'r Ymddiriedolaeth Genedlaethol am y tirlithriad. Maen nhw wedi cyflogi contractwyr i godi'r malurion a gwneud gwaith cywiros i'r stepiau a'r bont, codi arwyddion rhybudd. Hyd yma 08/03/21, nid oes neb wedi dod i'r safle eto.
- (c) **Sticil Llwybr Troed Penyparc:** adroddwyd am y 3ydd tro, dim ymateb hyd yma. Byddaf yn ffonio un ohonynt yn uniongyrchol os na dderbynnyr ymateb mis hwn.
- (ch) **Pengarn Pile:** rhoddydwyd adborth gan yr adran briffyrrd ac amcan bris. Mae angen i'r Cyngor Cymuned benderfynu ble maen nhw am wario a gwneud cais i'r adran briffyrrd ar ôl penderfynu ar leoliad. Cyf: TDJ/MH/Hwys40. Yn dibynnu ar y lleoliad a pha fath o reolaeth traffig dros dro fydd ei angen yn ystod y gwaith gosod, byddwn yn amcangyfrif mai'r gost fydd rhwng £350 a £1000, mwy os bydd angen goleuadau traffig dros dro.
- (d) **Cronfa ddŵr Penyparc:** siaradwyd â rheolwr Dŵr Cymru a derbyniwyd gwybodaeth gan beiriannydd lleol, mae'n debyg bod y broblem wedi'i thrwsio. Cerddais i fyny yno, nid oedd arwydd bod unrhyw ddŵr yn rhedeg o'r ardal nac ar y trac i'r ffordd fawr.
- (dd) Mae niferoedd Covid yn parhau i gwympo ledled Cymru a Ceredigion sydd â'r gyfradd achosion 7 diwrnod isaf ar hyn o bryd. Bydd y rhaglen frechu'n cyrraedd mwyaf y grŵp blaenoriaeth 55+ o 22 Mawrth ymlaen.
- (e) Cymuned Felinwynt, prosiect bandeang, mae disgwyl i'r prosiect ddechrau ym mis Ebrill i alluogi ffibr i'r ardal.
- (f) Bydd rhan o'r llwybr arfordir rhwng y Flat Rock a'r olygfan yn cael tarmac o gwmpas 15 Mawrth. Awgrymu bod y Cyngor Cymuned yn cael gair gyda'r contractwr i weld a ellir cael ateb cost is i'r olygfan gan fod y contractwr a'i offer nesaf at yr olygfan. Mae'n bosibl mai ateb tymor byr yw hwn am y tymor sydd o'u blaenau gyda rhywfaint o is-sylfaen a rholiwr. Ar gais y cyngor cymuned rydw i wedi:

Bydd Cyngor Treth Ceredigion yn codi 3.5%, sef cyfartaledd Cymru. I gymharu, mae Sir Gaerfyrddin 3.5%, Powys 3.95%, Sir Benfro 3.75%. Y prif wahaniaeth yw mai achos gwraidd y ffigur hwn yw codiad gwael gan Lywodraeth Cymru i Geredigion ar 2%, o gymharu â Chasnewydd Gwent sy'n cael y cyfraniad uchaf o 5.6% gan Lywodraeth Cymru. I gymharu, derbyniodd Sir Gaerfyrddin 3.8%, Sir Benfro 4%, Powys 4%. Eleni, ni wnaeth Llywodraeth Cymru roi llawr cyllido ar waith i ganiatáu isafswm codiad. Mae'r canlyniad hwn yn arwain at sir Ceredigion yn defnyddio cronfeydd canolig i lenwi'r bwlch a lleihau'r effaith ar wasanaethau.

- Chairperson's welcome.** The Chairperson, Cllr Lloyd Jenkins, welcomed everyone to the March meeting. It was noted that the meeting would be recorded for the purpose of minute writing. Cllr Auriol Williams was welcomed back to the meeting. The Clerk thanked the members for the flowers she received following her accident.

- Apologies for absence:**

It was proposed by Cllr Dilwyn Jenkins and seconded by Cllr. Lyn Jones that the minutes of the February meeting be recorded as correct.

- Declaration of personal interests:** None

- Matters arising:**

(a) **Cae Gwyrdd Penparc** – Neal has cleaned up the green stains on the paths and equipment and is about to lay the turf. Cllr. Melanie Davies confirmed that he hadn't been there yet to lay the turf.

(b) **Gwbert Viewpoint** – More quotes had been received for this work. The recent quote from Dyfed Symmonds was discussed.

Cllr. Clive Davies mentioned that additional money had come from the Welsh Government to lay tarmac on the coastal path from the viewpoint to the entrance of the Cliff Hotel. TTS would be completing works there on Monday if the Council would like to discuss with them.

The Clerk mentioned that she had spoken to Nick Doyle about a price but he hadn't been down to look yet.

Cllr. Dilwyn Jenkins noted he had also discussed the possible issue of concreting with Ieuan Davies and Sons who could bring a price.

Cllr Lyn Jones asked where did the Council stand in terms of whether we were allowed to do the work. Cllr. Melanie Davies stated that she had asked 2 individuals at the County Council but hadn't received a reply. Some councillors noted that they didn't think we were allowed to do anything. It was noted that it was the holes that needed filling. Cllr. Peter Williams stated that we needed to know who exactly is responsible for improving the car park, was it the community council or its owner, the County Council.

Cllr. Clive Davies will ask Arwyn Davies from the council about the viewpoint.

(c) **Warning road signs for Cae Gwyrdd** – Cllr. Clive Davies has spoken to the Welsh Government who wants to know who will be paying for the signs. He has asked the Highways Dept who will be paying. After he receives a reply, he will go back to Welsh Government to confirm either way.

(d) **Pengarn Pile** – It was decided to install the sign on the hedge at the layby.

(e) Meeting with Catrin Newbold – Has offered to meet with Council members. Questions are needed. Cllr. Eurig Lloyd agreed to be present. Delyth could take notes. Everyone was asked to submit questions by Friday night.

10. Other Matters:

- (a) **Public footpath between Trecefn Ganol and Trecefn Uchaf** – Trashing work needs to be done here as people want to walk the path but cannot. Ask John Morris to do this work.
- (b) **Stile** – Still has not been fixed and has worsened.
- (c) **Rotten fence posts at Gwbert** – Need to be fixed. Cllr Clive Davies will enquire.

- (d) **LORAWAN sensors** – sensors at Mwnt were discussed to get data on the numbers of visitors to this area. Data would help in decision making in the future. It was proposed by Cllr. Lloyd Jenkins and seconded by Cllr Llinos Price that this work is done.

11. County Councillor's Report – Cllr Clive Davies:

(a) **Playground signage:** Waiting for response from Ceredigion on payment for new signage. Case remaining open with Trunk Road Agency -A487 Penparc Cardigan Playground signage and visibility splay xref: OC-01291-20 (Rhys Ryland).

(b) **Mwnt:** Contact National Trust regarding the landslide. They have employed contractors to remove the debris and make good steps and bridge, erect warning signs. To date 8/3/21 no one on site yet.

(c) **Penparc Footpath Stile:** reported for a 3rd time , no response so far. Will phone one of the time directly if no response received this month.

(d) **Pengarn pile:** provided feedback from highways and rough cost. Community Council need to decide whether they want to spend and make an application to highways once location decided. Ref: TDJ/MH/Hwys40. Depending on the actual location, and what form of temporary traffic management may be required during the installation work, I would estimate the cost at being between £350 and £1000, more if temporary traffic lights may be required.

(e) **Penparc water reservoir :** Spoken to Dwr Cymru manager and received information from local engineer, the problem has apparently been fixed. Took a walk up there, no sign of any water running from the area or on the track to the main road.

(f) Covid numbers continue to fall across Wales and Ceredigion remains the lowest 7-day case rate for now. Vaccination programme will reach the 55+ priority group from March 22nd onwards.

(g) Felinwynt community, Fibre Broadband, project is to start in April to enable the area Fibre

(h) Section of coastal path between flat rock and viewpoint is to be tarmac'd from around 15th March. Suggest Community council have a word with contractor to see whether a lower costed solution for the viewpoint could be found while the contract and their equipment is next to the viewpoint. Possibly a short term solution for the season ahead with some sub base and a roller. At the request of the community council have:

- Emailed Arwyn Davies from estates to respond to Clerc
- Emailed contact details of contractor to Clerc.

(i) Council Tax for Ceredigion is to an increase of 3.5% which the average for Wales. As examples Carmarthenshire 3.5%, Powys 3.95%, Pembrokeshire 3.75%. The main difference a root cause of this figure is the poor uplift from Welsh Government for Ceredigion at 2%, compared to Newport Gwent with the highest contribution from Welsh Government of 5.6%. To compare Carmarthen received 3.8%, Pembrokeshire 4%, Powys 4%. Welsh Government this year did not apply a funding floor to allow a minimum uplift. This outcome results in Ceredigion using central funds to fill the gap and reduce the impact on services.
